

# WHAT GREATER GIFT CAN YOU GIVE?

When someone passes away, extend them a Plenary Indulgence. It is so easy. If you received Communion daily, went to Confession monthly, and fulfilled the conditions below- you could release a soul to Heaven every day of your life!

**Conditions for a Plenary Indulgence:** 

Be in the state of grace. Receive Communion each time a Plenary Indulgence is sought. Go to Confession within 20 days before of after doing the prescribed work. Have a disposition of Catholic detachment of sin, even venial sin. Pray for the intentions for the Pope, preferably one Our Father and one Hail Mary. Have at least a general intention to gain a plenary indulgence.

Fulfill at least one of the following:

- -at least 1/2 hr of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament
- -Family or group Rosary
- -Private Rosary before the Blessed Sacrament -at least 1/2 hr of pious reading of Sacred Scripture -walking the Stations of the Cross in a church
