

Q: Hey Bulletin Lady, why is there (New) and (Trad) behind the saints names?

A: Thank you for your question! The Bulletin Lady uses the 16-Month Saints Calendar by Tan Books to compile the list of saints in the bulletin. In both the New and Traditional calendars, (see opposite page) Saturdays are devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary, honoring her steadfast faith on the first Holy Saturday when the faith of the Apostles was shaken by Our Lord's crucifixion. Both liturgical calendars source from the 776-page volume Roman Martyrology, which itself is not an exhaustive list of all the saints legitimately venerated in the Catholic Church.
