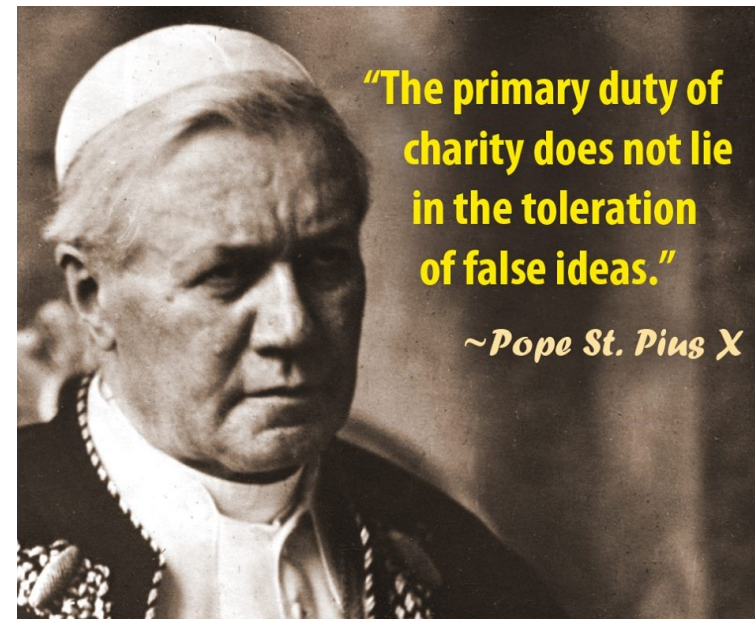

What are First Friday and First Saturday Devotions?

The First Friday devotion and First Saturday devotion are both reparatory devotions that arose from separate private revelations. The First Friday devotion is associated with the Sacred Heart of Jesus, while the First Saturday devotion is associated with the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Both devotions involve receiving Holy Communion on consecutive first Fridays or first Saturdays of the month, and both give a special promise of Divine assistance at the hour of death, that is, the promise of dying in a state of grace and therefore obtaining heaven.
