INTO THE DEEP - Feedback

This weekend the Diocese of Madison requests your feedback. Please prayerfully consider your feedback and submit it at the following webpage: <https://intothedeep.org/feedback>

The process will continue until December 11, and there are two specific topics for which feedback is requested: the general *Into the Deep* process, and the specific pastorate model proposed.

The type of feedback that is helpful for the *Into the Deep* Strategic Planning Committee is feedback which offers concrete solutions to help improve the model.

Examples:

✓ **Helpful feedback:** I think that it would be better for St. Mary's 's Parish to be in Pastorate #___ instead of #19 because of reasons A, B, and C.

✓ **Helpful feedback:** I don't think that it makes sense for St. Mary's Parish to be in Pastorate 19 reasons X, Y, and Z.

✗ **Unhelpful feedback:** I don't like the other parishes that our parish is grouped with.

✗ **Unhelpful feedback:** I don't want to work and worship with *those people!*

Joining together, we can come strengthen our church, parish and pastorate, creating a brighter future for our Diocese and our faith!
