LITURGY OF THE WORD

Reading I: Is 50:4-17: *The suffering Servant of the Lord.*

Tract: Ps 22:2–9, 18, 19, 22, 24, 32 *in Latin*

My God, my God, look upon me, why have you forsaken me? *ψ*. My words of sin have drawn me far from salvation. *ψ*. O my God, I call by day and you give no reply; I call by night and not without reason. *ψ*. Yet, you dwell in the sanctuary; you are the praise of Israel. *ψ*. Our fathers placed their hope in you; they trusted you and you delivered them. *ψ*. They cried out to you and they were saved; they put their hope in you and they were not confounded. *ψ*. But I am a worm and no man; scorned by men and despised by the people. *ψ*. All who see me mock at me, they make mouths at me, they wag their heads. *ψ*. “He trusted in the Lord; let him deliver him, let him rescue him, for he delights in him.” *ψ*. And so they looked and gazed upon me; they divided my garments among themselves, and for my raiment they have cast lots. *ψ*. Save me from the mouth of the lion; my afflicted soul from the horns of the unicorn. *ψ*. You who fear the Lord, praise him! All you sons of Jacob, glorify him. *ψ*. A future generation shall be announced on behalf of the Lord, and the heavens will declare his justice; *ψ*. Unto a nation yet to be born, and whom the Lord has prepared.

Reading II: Phil 2:6–11: *The mystery of Christ, humbled and exalted.*

Gradual: Phil 2:8, *ψ*. 9 *in Latin*

Christ became obedient for us unto death, even death on a Cross. *ψ*. Therefore God has highly exalted him, and bestowed on him the name which is above every name.

Gospel: Mt 26:14–27:66 or 27:11–54: *The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.*
