CATHOLIC SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Parish Council has approved a continuation of the Catholic School Scholarship Program for the 2021-2022 school year. Once again, a \$500 scholarship is available to students attending a Catholic School (Grades 1-12), with partial scholarships for 5K and 4K. Seminarians and those enrolled as Novice also are eligible for a \$500 scholarship. A \$250 scholarship is available for Holy Family Home Schoolers (K-12).

VISIT A CEMETERY NOVEMBER 1ST THRU 8TH

PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR ALL SOULS

November is dedicated to the Holy Souls and from Nov. 1 thru Nov. 8, a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Poor Souls in Purgatory is granted to those who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed, provided that the usual conditions are met. Partial indulgences are granted to those who recite Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead, and to those who recite the Eternal Rest Prayer. (See Below) Only one indulgence may be granted each day but a partial indulgence may be granted more than once a day. On All Souls Day a plenary indulgence for Poor Souls will be granted to those who visit any parish church or public oratory ad there recite one Our Father and one Credo. A cemetery visit is not required. The usual conditions to acquire a plenary indulgence are sacramental confession, eucharistic Communion, prayer for the intention of the Holy Father, and detachment from sin, even venial sin. If these conditions are not met, the indulgence will be partial.
