CATHOLIC SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

The Parish Council has approved a continuation of the Catholic School Scholarship Program for the 2021-2022 school year. Once again, a \$500 scholarship is available to students attending a Catholic School (Grades 1-12), with partial scholarships for 5K and 4K.
