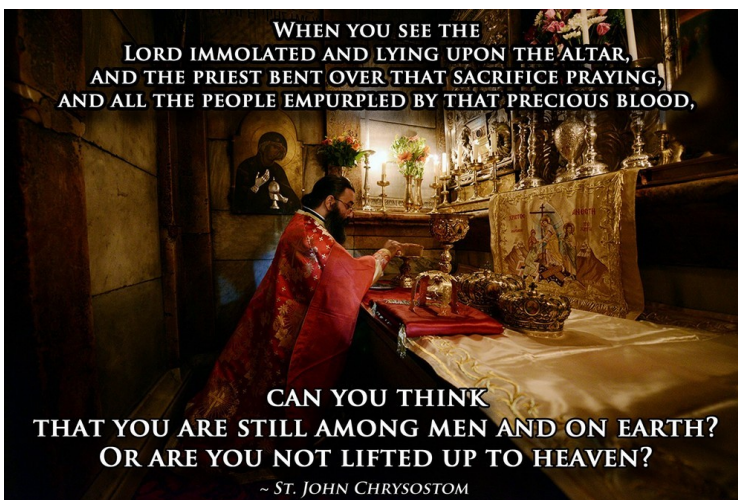
CONFESSION: Confession, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, is available after Daily Mass or anytime by contacting Father Rick in his office at 608.798.4644

DID YOU KNOW: St. Robert Bellarmine

- St. Robert Bellarmine is the patron saint of Bishop Robert Morlino†
- St. Robert Bellarmine was related to a pope
- He was spiritual director to St. Aloysius Gonzaga, a fellow Jesuit
- In 1616, under order from Pope Paul V, he notified Galileo that his theory of heliocentricity was opposed to biblical teaching and could not at the time be supported by the Church.
