CONFESSION: Confession, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, is available after Daily Mass or anytime by contacting Father Rick in his office at 608.798.4644

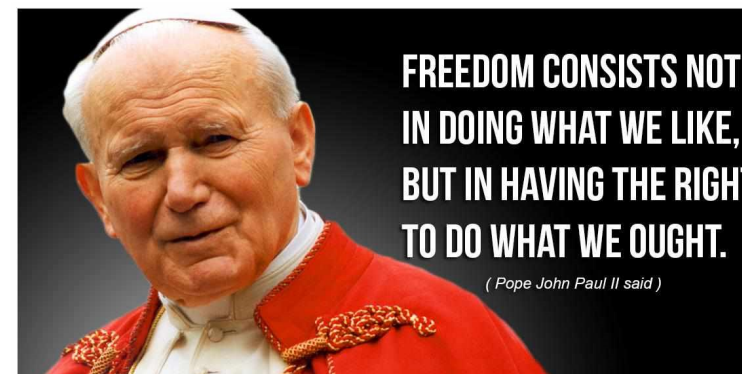

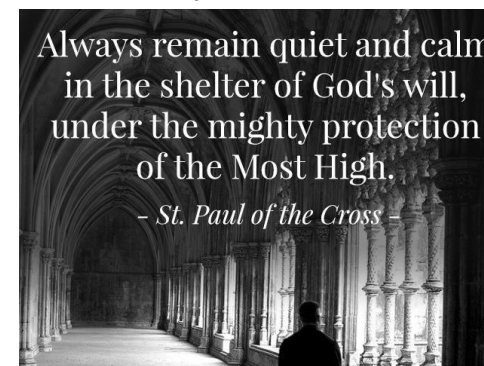
