# INTOTEDEP

Dear family,

I want to share a few Into the Deep and other parish-related items with you.

- 1. Over the past few weeks, St. Mary's staff and the future Pastorate 19 leadership has been doing a lot of prep work/ behind the scenes work to prepare for July 1st and the beginning of Into the Deep implementation. In particular, Fr. Scott who will be serving as Parochial Administrator for the Pastorate has met with most of the staff members from St. Bernard, St. Peter, St. Martin, and St. Mary to get to know us and our parishes. Furthermore, the Pastorate 19 Priest Team (Fr. Tait Schroeder, Fr. Brian Dulli, Fr. Michael Wanta, and Fr. Scott) met with Bishop Hying to discuss various aspects of our pastorate and to begin to think through a new Mass/Confession schedule, which hopefully will be finalized and shared by June 1.
- 2. One of the first issues that needed to be addressed is where each of the priests will live come July 1. All four incoming priests desire to live with at least one other priest (for the sake of community, to share meals, to be able to pray together, etc.), so after some discussion and prayer, Fr. Tait and Fr. Scott will be moving to the Saint Bernard rectory in Middleton, and Fr. Brian and Fr. Michael will live in the rectory at Saint Francis Xavier in Cross Plains. This means there will not be a priest living in the St. Mary's rectory after July 1 (Fr. Scott will be working with St. Mary's leadership after this date to discern how best to use the rectory). There were some practical considerations for why this setup was chosen. Fr. Tait will be working Tuesday-Friday at Holy Name Heights/the chancery in his role as Director of Into the Deep Implementation, so it made sense to have him live as close as possible to the chancery. Fr. Scott plans on keeping his primary office at Saint Francis Xavier (at least for the time being) since it is central to all of the parishes in the Pastorate plus, Fr. Tait and Fr. Scott have gotten used to living together over the past few months. Meanwhile, Fr. Michael will be serving as the primary "chaplain" for the school students at Saint Francis Xavier and Saint Peter Schools, and Fr. Brian will be the priest primarily serving the TLM community here in Pine Bluff, so it made sense for both priests to live relatively nearby. No matter where each priest lives, expect to see each of them regularly throughout the pastorate, however.
- 3. Finally, the St. Mary of Pine Bluff Pastoral and Finance Councils will keep their current members for the time being. Although our annual SMPB Pastoral Council Election was forthcoming, the current council has decided to postpone it until a single Pastorate-wide Pastoral Council is formed in the future (this same practice is what many other parishes through the diocese are doing). While the date for creation of a unified pastoral council has not been definitively determined, more information will be provided in due time when it is available (most likely sometime after the new year). Plans for a single unified Finance Council will also be forthcoming sometime in 2024. Once again, more information will be made available in due time. Thanks for your patience and understanding!
